



ASHRAFUL AID PROVIDES HUMANITARIAN

RELIEF IN KWA-ZULU NATAL

The recent unrest in South Africa has had a significant impact on businesses, the livelihood of employers, employees, as well as the needs of communities.

When shops were destroyed and access to basic household items were not easily accessible, Ashraful Aid's disaster relief team arranged for essential items to reach KZN by July 15th for distribution through the help of volunteers, NPOs', local organisations and community leaders on the ground.

Our first aim was to ensure we reach the elderly and the vulnerable. While we tried to accommodate individual requests, this was not always possible due to the scale of the need across so many communities. 50 Tons of goods were packed and distributed to various areas in KZN. This included food hampers, baby formula, baby nappies and groceries.

Our work for KZN will proceed into its next phase with a needs analysis of projects requiring further support in the weeks and months ahead. This phase commences at the beginning of August to support the rebuilding of KZN.

LAUNCH OF REMOTE MONITORING OF CRIME HOTSPOTS IN MARLBORO GARDENS



Services, have launched a remote CCTV monitoring network of crime hotspots in parts of Marlboro Gardens, Sandton. This initiative comes after an increase of crime incidents were reported in the area. Ashraful Aid provided the capital outlay for the infrastructure and project management, while MNW will provide the ongoing monitoring and security response services.

Ashraful Aid Executive Director, Moulana Suhail Wadee explained what led to the launch of this project in the area, "As a humanitarian organisation based in the community of Marlboro for over 2 decades, we felt it was important to partner with and give back to our local community. In an effort to reduce crime in the Marlboro area and to make people feel safe and more secure, we decided to kick off and invest in this important community project. We are grateful to MNW who didn't hesitate to come on board and offer their support"
